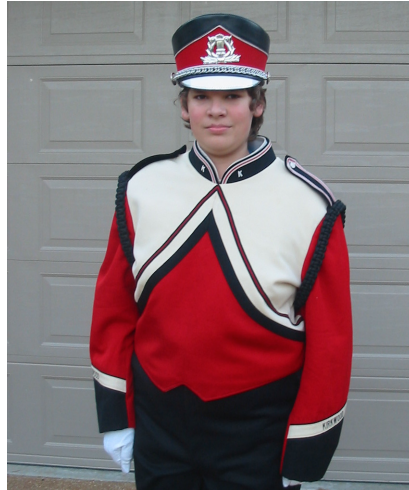


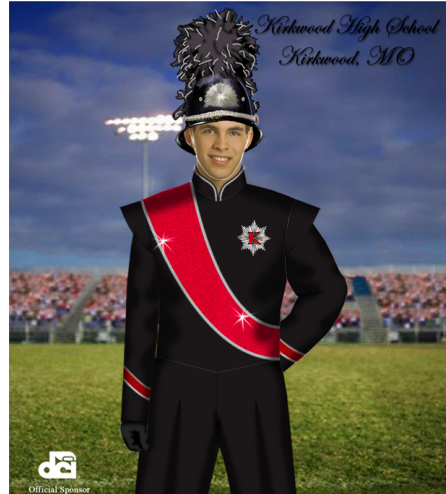
# Out With The Old and In With The New
